- 1. All truck drivers should be on Channel 10 throughout the Convoy so that open communication is available. We will make sure that the lead and last truck are able to communicate with law enforcement should an incident arise.
- 2. DO NOT leave your parking spot until instructed to do so. When we are done with the auction, the lead bid trucks and sponsor trucks will line up first and then the volunteers with bright yellow vests and orange flags will direct drivers to leave your spots in order, by rows nose to tail. Look at the map given to you at registration.
- 3. All trucks in the Convoy **MUST** stay in the right lane for the entire Convoy. Once the Convoy begins, the ramps will be blocked to allow the Convoy to continue traveling at a constant speed; however traffic will continue northbound in the left lane of Interstate 41. We MUST get trucks up to 60 miles an hour since 41 is now an interstate.
- 4. Please be courteous and allow cars to exit off of the interstate if they need to. We DO NOT want traffic stopping in the left lane at any time.
- 5. The Convoy will travel directly to EAA and will exit at Hwy 26 in Oshkosh which is Exit #113.
- 6. The goal is to travel at 60 mph AFTER all trucks have entered the highway. Until then, we will travel at 50 mph. Please travel at a safe distance from the truck in front of you, but keep it at a steady pace. Based on past experience, we need to keep the Convoy tight so we do not have onramps closed for a long period of time.
- 7. All drivers should have their lights and flashers on throughout the Convoy as well as the orange ribbon tied to the driver's side mirror and the number on your driver's side dash you were given at registration as an identifier that you are part of the Convoy.
- **8.** When arriving at EAA, all trucks MUST be parked on hard surfaces! Be sure to go where you are directed by the volunteers with the yellow safety vests and orange flags when you get there. There will be a tram continually running to transport drivers from the parking area so you do not have to walk the distance to

the pavilion. Please park where directed as parking areas may have changed and many areas within EAA are in flight patterns of small aircraft.

- 10. When arriving at EAA, be sure to wave to the Special Olympics athletes. They will be on the west side of the frontage road in the brown lot across from the museum on Poberezny Road.
- 11. When arriving at EAA also be sure to wave to law enforcement and parking officials as they choose their favorite truck!
- 12. Those not driving a truck in the Convoy may want to exit the Interstate at Highway 44, Exit number 116 and enter the EAA from the North and go to Waukau and look for signs that direct you to parking near the pavilion.

All trucks will line up behind the trucks who bid for the lead positions. Then we'll have one truck from E.H. Wolf, our Platinum Partner.

Next up will be our athletes riding in a bus donated by Go Riteway Transport Group. Then everyone else will be directed to pull out in rows nose to tail in the order you are parked. PLEASE DO NOT MOVE UNTIL DIRECTED TO DO SO.

PLEASE follow the signal of the volunteers with the orange flags to make sure everyone is in order. The last truck in the Convoy will be a truck from Roskopf's Service & Towing with a "Convoy in Progress" banner displayed.
