- 7. Experience with not-for-profits or in the field of intellectual disabilities helpful, but not required.
- 8. Willingness to work some evenings and weekends
- 9. Ability to work independently and with a minimum amount of supervision
- 10. Valid Wisconsin driver's license.
- 11. Must pass necessary background check.
