No Ball at All

This is easy. You invite businesses to a ball that does not exist. As soon as they read the entire invitation they realize they are being asked for a donation. The invitation can be done professionally or on good card stock purchased at one of the stores carrying quality paper. Or ask your arts and crafts friends to make them up for you. Even your athletes can make them up. If you have a list of 200 or more businesses, you can use bulk mailing!

- 1. Draw up a list of potential businesses. Use the phone book. Doctors, dentists, clinic, lawyers, mortician, almost any business should be on your list.
- 2. Mail out invitations
- 3. It may take a few years of doing this before seeing larger amounts of money but try repeating this for at least two years. Refine and add to your first list the second year.
- 4. You may want to include a return envelope for their donation.
