4. State mandated new rules this year (or strictly enforced previous rules) are:
  - NO ONE except those registered for the State Tournament are allowed in the dorm areas (rooms, elevator, etc.) at any time! Athletes will need to be picked up and dropped off outside of the dorms. A coach, Jackie or Mary will need to accompany anyone getting gear early. (For example, after the Softball Tournament)
  - No dogs are allowed at tournaments.
  - No smoking while at any Special Olympic practice or tournament.
  - Buses are for the athletes and coaches only. We are no longer allowed to provide spectator transportation.
  - Due to liability, athlete focus/ concentration and coach respect, all spectators need to remain seated in the designated spectator area. Parents are responsible for direct supervision of non athletes in their care 100% of the time.
  - The new age for volunteering is 14.
