STEP 1:

Find your Plunge

Select from eight locations across the state, plus an Alternative do-it-yourself option.

STEP 2:

Register Online

Complete your registration via the new Funraise platform. Select the Team option, designate either K/12 or College/University group, then select either UCS or Non-UCS.

STEP 3:

Recruit your Plunge Squad

The larger your team, the more impact you'll make—and the more financial support your school program will receive.

STEP 4:

Raise those Funds!
